
On Saturday, May 11, 2024 she will return to sing and perform as Eleanor Roosevelt at the Future ICL, part of her Women: Back to the Future series, to raise awareness and funds for the Ionia Community Library Foundation (ICLF). Kate has heartfelt memories growing up in Ionia and many revolve around the library. She realizes, "Our Ionia Community needs an up-to-date library with plenty of meeting spaces to nurture current and future generations providing an exciting safe place to expand their minds." This is nothing new to Kate, Dr. Campbell was on the Library Board for over 35 years and was one of the people spearheading the refurbishment of the Hall-Fowler home in the late 1950's and early 1960's.
