
Map Use Guide


Navigate to the website. The map is embedded beneath the Mi Library Finder logo. Click on the "four corners" button in the black header bar of the map to be taken to the searchable map.






Click the "four corners" icon in the upper right open the full map and search for your address.


After opening the map, click the magnifying glass at the top of the lefthand menu.




This will open the search menu. Enter the address you are searching for. If Google can match the address, it will auto-populate below the search bar. You can either hit enter or click on the auto-populated address to search.



The Map will put a dot at the address - note that it will zoom in to street level. The screen will be full of one color, as that represents the library's service area.



To see which library's service area this address falls into, click anywhere on the colored area of the screen. This will show you the library and the municipality that the address belongs to. The description will have links to the library website, a link to their card application or info how to get a card with them (if applicable), and a link to the library's location(s) on google maps.



If that's your library, great! If it's not, you know exactly where to direct them.
