## Donations

### A Regular or One-Time Gift

## Bequests and Planned Giving: Leave a Legacy

### Bequests, Wills & Codicils

You may designate the library in your will or bequest as a beneficiary for the transfer of assets such as cash, stock, insurance and real property.

Including the library in your will is simple, even if you already have one. Make changes to your will by executing an amendment called a codicil. Your attorney, or qualified estate planner should draft both your will and codicil.

Your will or codicil should refer to the Ionia Community Library presently located at 126 East Main Street, Ionia, Michigan 48846. The library's Tax I.D. number is 76-0760195. All persons are advised to seek independent legal advice with regard to wills and individual circumstances.



Bequests that are specifically designated for capital improvements or special programs are welcome, but unrestricted bequests allow the library's trustees to apply the gift where the need is greatest.

### Planned Giving

Planned giving can be tailored to your unique circumstances and provide long-term support to the library, while saving you in estate, gift and income taxes. Naming the library as a beneficiary of your retirement plan assets, such as an IRA, or your life insurance policy, may also provide tax savings and help protect your assets.
